

The Colorado State USBC 2016-2017 Merged Association Bylaws have been codified to conform with the adoption of Adult Bylaws Proposal No B-3 which became effective immediately upon adoption by the delegates' approval at the 2017 USBC Convention April 24-27, 2017, at The Orleans in Las Vegas, NV.

Article VII, Meetings  
Section A, Annual Meeting  
Item 9, Quorum

Read:

The Board and Delegates determine the number.

- a. **25 Adult Delegates representing adult members constitute a quorum.**
- b. **4 Youth Delegates constitute a quorum for youth.**

Now reads:

The Board and Delegates determine the number.

**29 Delegates constitute a quorum.**

Until the Colorado State USBC makes a change to its bylaws, the youth and adult quorum number is combined.

The reason for this proposal as presented by USBC Legal and Legislative Committee is:

Currently, associations are required to meet both an adult quorum as well as a youth quorum in order to conduct business. Failure to meet both quorums would result in no action being able to be taken by the association.

A local association elects Delegates representing Adults and Youth to send to the state Annual Meeting. These Delegates, regardless if representing adults or youth, are making decisions together which affect all members. Since everyone is voting together, the quorum should also be combined, and will simplify the credentials process for the state association.
