

1. Scholarships fees shall be returned 100% to bowlers based on 1 in 7 entries in each division in each region. Scholarships will be held in USBC Smart Program (Account Number #10926).
2. NOTE DRESS CODE: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Shirts/Blouses must have collars and sleeves. Sponsor T-Shirts and the USBC Youth Jersey are acceptable. Bowlers must wear full length slacks or jeans (no ragged, torn, holey, or sagging jeans). No headgear will be allowed. This Rule will be enforced. No smoking allowed for athlete during competition. No Cell phones are allowed during competition.
3. Eligibility – Open to all Youth bowlers who have a paid membership in any Colorado State USBC Youth league in accordance with USBC Rule 400.
4. Competitors will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes and can only compete one time only.
5. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes of practice on starting pair only.
6. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made up. A bowler not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame. If you must leave the settee area, please notify a tournament official.
7. Bowlers shall use their highest current certified league average, minimum of twelve (12) games, as of January 1, 2016. Averages must be verified by a standing sheet. If you don't have twelve games as January 1, 2016, you will have to use your highest league average, of 12 games or more, as of squad time (verified by standing sheet) or you will use last years certified average.
8. The handicap will be 80% of 190.
9. Only bowlers, tournament officials & center staff shall be permitted in the settee area.
10. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be in writing to the tournament director within the 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
11. REFUNDS – USBC Rule 314. After an entry has been received and the dates assigned by tournament management, are not refused before the preparation of the schedule, the entry fee cannot be refunded after February 23, 2016.
12. PROTESTS – Any protest affecting eligibility or Tournament Rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Manager, with a copy to the United States Bowling Congress, within 72 hours of the occurrence.
13. USBC Youth Rules will apply in all instances not specifically the covered by these rules.
