**RULES OF THE WAYNE AND TRUDY TODD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT**

1. **HANDICAP/AVERAGE:** Handicap will be 90% of 440. – **THE HIGHEST AVERAGE USE HIGHEST 2021-2022 USBC certified league AVERAGE OF 21 GAMES OR MORE** and if your average of 21 games is higher as of March 1, 2023, you will use that for your tournament entering average. If you have neither of the above, then you can use a 12-game average as of the May 6, 2023, the start of the tournament. If no average exists, All Male Adult Bowlers will be assigned a 175 average and all Female Adult Bowlers a 165 average. Youth bowlers will use their average as reported for the Championship Tournament. Incorrectly reported averages will be handled in accordance with USBC rule 319(a-3). USBC rule 319e will be waived.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Colorado USBC youth members who are members of leagues where no money or merchandise prizes have been awarded. All youth entrants **MUST** have a paid Colorado membership and adult bowlers **MUST** have a paid Colorado membership or pay the tournament participation fee of \$5.00 for adult female or male entrants in accordance with USBC rule 300(c-1/b).
3. **ENTRIES:** Multiple participation will be allowed in accordance with USBC rule 315(b-2). Rule 301(c/1) will be in effect to allow an adult's score to be matched with several youths' scores for the purpose of determining doubles totals. All entries must be submitted with the corresponding fees prior to the adult's participation.
4. **FORMAT:** Each doubles entrant will bowl three (3) games.
5. **DIVISIONS:** The following Divisions will be used for the tournament based on the Youth bowler's age as of August 1, 2022: Girls 11 & under, Girls 12 & above and Boys 11 & under, Boys 12 & above.
6. **AWARDS:** Plaques will be given in each division to first and second place only. Awards fees will be returned 100%. Awards will be mailed to the winners.
7. **SCHOLARSHIPS:** Scholarships will be awarded in each division to youth bowlers only and the amount will be based on the number of entries in each individual division and given on the basis of one (1) for every (7) entries in the specific division. Scholarships are held for up to six (6) years after High School graduation and will be kept in the USBC SMART PROGRAM.
8. **TARDY PLAYERS:** An entrant arriving late will receive a zero (0) for all frames missed. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn or a zero (0) may be given.
9. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Shirts or blouses with collars and sleeves, Sponsor T-shirts, Bowling Jersey, and Performance crew are acceptable. Bowlers must wear full length slacks or jeans, shorts to the knee or skorts that extend to the knee when worn at the waist 3-3 ½ inches above the knee. No athletic wear will be allowed including but not limited to basketball shorts, sweats, leggings, and yoga pants. (No ragged, torn, holey, or sagging jeans). No headwear of any kind can be worn. **Rule 301b** – prohibits youth bowlers from wearing apparel or using bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, illegal substances, or inappropriate language/gestures during youth tournament competition. **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED DURING COMPETITION. THE DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
10. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED IN THE SETTEE AREA.
11. NO USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS OR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED BY ANY OF THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE TOURNAMENT WHILE BOWLING.
12. USBC YOUTH RULES WILL APPLY IN ALL INSTANCES NOT SPECIFICALLY COVERED BY THESE RULES.
