# Rules of the Colorado State USBC Mixed Bowling Tournament

- DRESS CODE** – Shorts/skirts must be longer than fingertips no holes in clothing and t-shirts or shirts must have sleeves. **No offensive language** .No hats or electronic devices are to be worn during tournament play; this includes electronic and vapor cigarettes. Final decisions as to attire will be left up to tournament management.
- BALL CLEANING:** After the entrant begins competition the outer surface of the ball may be cleaned with a dry towel/cloth only. No use of liquids of any kind. Non-compliance may result in loss of use of that ball for the remainder of the competition.
- MULTIPLE TEAM EVENTS** - Entrants may bowl more than once in the team event, however no more than two (2) players from one team may participate together on another team, USBC RULE 315b (1). A bowler participating more than once in the team event MUST count his/her first team score for All-Events.
- MULTIPLE DOUBLES EVENTS** – Must change bowling partners. His/her first Doubles event score will count for All-events.
- ELIGIBILITY** - All participants shall be male or female bowlers who are members of a Colorado Local Association, chartered by the United States Bowling Congress. **Current USBC membership cards must be presented at check-in.** Non USBC members who are residents of the State of Colorado, and/or nonresidents who are members of a Chartered Colorado Local Association without a current membership card, may qualify for entry by making an application for membership and remitting the USBC fee of \$22.00.  
“NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 CAN BOWL IN THIS TOURNAMENT”.
- AVERAGES** – USE HIGHEST 2024-2025 USBC certified league AVERAGE OF 21 GAMES OR MORE. A bowler without a 2024-2025 average may use their highest 2025-2026 USBC certified league average of 21 games or more as of the starting date of the tournament (July 11, 2026). If a bowler has none of the above, an average of 220 will be assigned with no handicap being offered. BOWLERS USING A July 11, 2026, AVERAGE must have the average verified by the league secretary, with verification presented at the time of bowling the first event.
- USBC RULE 319a, PARAGRAPH 2 (10) PIN RULE APPLIES.** If the bowlers average of 21 or more games as of July 11, 2026, is 10 pins higher than the 2024-2025 certified league average, the highest average must be used.
- AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT (Rerating)- Bowler's tournament average adjustment (Rule319e) APPLIES TO THIS TOURNAMENT.**
- VERIFICATION OF AVERAGES** - It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections prior to the completion of the first game of a competition shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
- HANDICAP** – Shall be based on 90% of 220
- PRIZE RATIO** - For Team Doubles and All-Events will be at least 1 in 7.
- PRIZE FEES** -100% of all prize fees collected will be returned to the participants in each event or division (Rule 308).
- AWARDS** – Will be awarded for first place winners in team, doubles, and all-events.
- TIES**- Should a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> Place occur in any event of the tournament “Co-Champions” shall be declared, with appropriate award to each, and prize money involved for 1<sup>st</sup> Place & 2<sup>ND</sup> Place shall be combined equally between the participants in the tie.
- REFUNDS**- USBC Rule 314. After an entry has been received, and the dates assigned by tournament management are not refused before preparation of the schedule, the entry fee cannot be refunded after July 11, 2026
- TEAM CAPTAINS**- Are the team representative and will serve in all matters pertaining to individual behavior and compliance with tournament and USBC rules. The team captain will be responsible to the Tournament Manager for the conduct of their team members throughout the times they are on the lanes in the competition.
- W-9's**- Any team whose members have not provided W-9's for IRS purposes may have their prize checks delayed until all W-9's are collected.
- REPLACEMENTS** - Are authorized by the team captain and must occupy the same position in the lineup as the original entrant. Once a replacement bowler has been added to the roster, and the replacement bowler has delivered the first ball in competition, the replacement bowler shall be allowed to complete the entire series.
- PACERS** - Are not permitted.
- CHECK-IN REQUIREMENTS**- ALL BOWLERS MUST CHECK-IN INDIVIDUALLY. Starting 1 hour prior to Squad time. Bowlers should not leave the center after they check-in as squads may start early once all bowlers have checked in and the lanes are available.
- PRACTICE STARTS 10 MINUTES PRIOR TO SQUAD STARTING TIME. COMPETITION STARTS AT POSTED TIME!**
- TARDY PLAYERS** - Will start in the frame being bowled when the tardy player is ready to compete, with zero score being recorded for all prior frames. NO MAKEUP FRAMES ALLOWED.
- SCORE SHEETS** - After a score sheet has been signed by the bowler or team captain, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error. Bowlers are cautioned not to sign score sheets before or during the competition. Computer printouts will be the official score sheet in case of discrepancies in scores.
- LOST SCORES** -SCOREKEEPERS USBC Rule 327a USBC 327c.
- PROTESTS** – RULES 329a (1) and 329b (1). Any protest affecting eligibility or Tournament Rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours of the infraction or prior to tournament prizes being paid, or whichever occurs first. The decision of the tournament manager is final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC headquarters within 10 days of notification of tournament management's decision.
- USBC RULES WILL GOVERN IN ALL INSTANCES NOT SPECIFICALLY COVERED BY ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES.
- Annual Mixed tournament shall include competition in four-person teams (2 men, 2 women) and doubles (1-man, 1 woman) and a six game all events division, scratch, and handicap. Women will compete against women and men against men in all events division. Teams are limited to 1 female or 1 male bowler who identifies themselves as a professional, limiting the number of professional bowlers to 1 on a four-person team and 1 on a doubles team.

\*\*\*SLOW BOWLING -3 hours are allowed for team and doubles. Entrants are expected to complete their competition within these time frames, if not, tournament staff may monitor entrants\*\*\*
